| 6.80L Transmission Line and No. 6 Substation Alteration



CHECKLIST APPLICATION

Project overview

ENMAX Power Corporation (ENMAX Power) owns and operates transmission line 6.80L (6.80L), a 138 kilovolt (kV) overhead line that connects into No. 6 Substation (the substation) located at 16300 37 St. SW, Calgary, AB, providing electrical service to surrounding communities in the southwest area of Calgary.

Planned land development

Dream Asset Management Corporation (the developer) is planning a new land development, near the substation and 6.80L, including the future 162 Avenue road corridor. To support this development and ensure continued safe and reliable electrical service, ENMAX Power has been requested to adjust its infrastructure to accommodate the developer's land development.

→ Proposed schedule

ENMAX Power intends to file a Checklist Application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) in **Q1 2026** for approval to replace six transmission structures and install four new transmission structures. The new structures will be located approximately 25 to 40 meters north of the current alignment (the Project). The Project will also involve relocating entry access to No. 6 Substation.

Subject to regulatory approvals and progress on nearby unrelated development, we expect construction to start in **Q2 2026**, with a project completion date in **Q2 2027**. For the latest updates and timelines, please visit enmax.com/No6substation.

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
What's being proposed?

Transmission line alteration:


- Six existing transmission structures will be replaced.
 - 2 self-supporting steel monopoles (monopoles)
 - 3 wood poles (poles)
 - 1 laminated wood pole
- Four new monopoles will be shifted approximately 25 to 40 meters north of their current locations.
- Structure heights will remain similar to the existing structures (between 19 and 27 meters in height).

Substation access changes:

- A new substation entry will be constructed on the south side of the substation, replacing the existing north side access.
- The new entry will maintain all ENMAX Power safety measures, with entry limited to authorized personnel.
- To accommodate the new entry, ownership of a small portion of land on the south side of the substation will be transferred from the developer to ENMAX Power, while ownership of a similar sized area on the north side will be transferred from ENMAX Power to the developer.



Illustrative example of a self-supporting steel monopole; final design may vary.




Illustrative example of a laminated wood pole; final design may vary.


