RE: ENMAX Power Corporation (ENMAX Power) Application Update
VARSITY NORTHWEST Transmission Line Letter of Enquiry Application

BACKGROUND

On February 22, 2023, ENMAX Power applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) to leave certain overhead portions of transmission lines 15.62L and 16.63L in place permanently (AUC proceeding #27965). On December 6, 2023, the AUC denied ENMAX Power's application in Decision 27965-D01-2023 and directed ENMAX Power to file a new application (Original Decision).

On June 14, 2024, the AUC initiated a review of the Original Decision (AUC proceeding #29097). The purpose of that review was to determine whether the Original Decision should be confirmed, rescinded, or varied.

UPDATE

On November 13, 2024, the AUC issued Decision 29097-D01-2024, where it varied the Original Decision and approved ENMAX Power's application filed in AUC proceeding #27965. Accordingly, transmission lines 15.62L and 16.63L will remain permanently as completely overhead transmission lines.

ENMAX Power appreciates the interest and feedback expressed by stakeholders throughout the regulatory processes for this Application.
