**RE: ENMAX Power Corporation Project Update
32 AVENUE NORTHWEST Transmission Line Letter of Enquiry Application**

On April 30, 2025, ENMAX Power Corporation (EPC) submitted an application to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) seeking approval to permanently retain certain overhead sections of Transmission Lines 16.60L and 21.61L (AUC Proceeding 30009).

A written hearing on the matter took place and concluded on August 28, 2025. During the hearing, parties submitted evidence and argument to the AUC.

On October 23, 2025, the AUC issued Decision 30009-D01-2025, approving EPC's request to leave certain overhead portions of transmission lines 16.60L and 21.61L in place permanently.

EPC appreciates the engagement and feedback provided by impacted stakeholders throughout the regulatory process for this application and would be happy to further discuss the decision or any other issues related to this project.
