RE: No. 27 Substation Rebuild Project

Dear Landowner/Resident/Occupant/Business Owner:

We would like to thank stakeholders who have participated in the consultation process to date. Your input is valued and has contributed to our understanding of community and stakeholder interests and considerations as Project planning has progressed. We are writing to provide an update about the proposed No. 27 Substation Rebuild Project.

Technical design for the substation has progressed, and a more detailed rendering is available on the project webpage at enmax.com/no27substation. For your convenience, a copy of the rendering is enclosed to provide an overview of the proposed design. The rendering represents ongoing design development and details that include:

- the proposed design, including potential landscaping where feasible, along the northern boundary of the rebuilt substation;
- the proposed equipment layout, including refined transformer locations and applicable clearance requirements within the substation.

We appreciate the feedback received through stakeholder consultation and recognize that many community members value the proposed Project area as greenspace, including the trees and park bench. Subject to project approval and final design, we will assess additional landscaping or low-growth vegetation, and will landscape and add low-growth vegetation, where feasible. We will also relocate the park bench to the eastern side of our property.

With respect to the Project location, the substation rebuild will occur on ENMAX owned property, while with the replacement of the existing wood pole on the west side of 14 Street will take place on land under jurisdiction by the City of Calgary.

Ongoing Engagement

We are committed to actively engaging with community members and obtaining your feedback about the proposed project, your input is valuable to us. The consultation process will allow us to review and respond to your concerns and include your feedback in our

project application. ENMAX Power plans to file a facility application for the Project with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) in the fall of 2026.
